TAUNTON DEANE SUMMER LEVEL 3 OPEN MEET 2015 CONDITIONS
11th and 12th July 2015, Hutton Moor 25M POOL, Weston-Super-Mare

- 1 The meet will be held under ASA law and technical rules and has been licensed by the ASA for entry into County and Area Championships and Competitions.
- 2 All competitors must be members of an affiliated club, eligible to compete and registered in accordance with ASA laws and technical rules and may enter in the name of one club only.
- 3 The promoter (Taunton Deane Swimming) reserves the right to reject any entry without giving a reason. By submitting entries on the official entry forms and discs, clubs and competitors accept the rules of this competition. Competitors whose entries are accepted and subsequently found to have been entered in the wrong event(s) a) because of incorrect entry information will be withdrawn from the event(s) and will not have their entry fees refunded. However, b) because of error by the organizer, will be withdrawn from the event(s) and will at the organizer's discretion and without further obligation or liability by the organizer either a) be entered in the correct event or b) receive a refund of the relevant entry fee(s).
- 4 The pool is 25m and the competition will be swum short course. Anti-wave devices will be in place and electronic timing/placing will be used wherever possible. The organizer reserves the right to ban the use of gas hooters, klaxons etc., which, in the organizers opinion, could be a hazard or a danger to swimmers, officials or spectators.
- 5 **Entries with times converted for a 25m pool** should be made via Hy-Tek team manager and e-mailed to tdswim.meet@gmail.com. Printout of Hy-Tek entry file (or clerical entry form if applicable) and payment form should reach the Meet Committee by 14th June 2015. The entry fee is **£5.00** per event. Coach passes are **£12.00** each. **Spectator entry £3 per session £5 for day and £10 for the weekend**, Weekend Event programme **£5.00**. Cheques should be made payable to Taunton Deane Swimming. Entry information will be sent to Club Secretaries, via email, on receipt of entries and correct fees
- 6 Competitor's entry times should be based on times actually achieved. As many heats as possible will be run in the time available for the Meet. The promoters reserve the right to amend the number of heats in each event depending on entry numbers. **There are maximum qualifying times on all events, these are set at ASA recommended grade A level.**
- 7 **The promoters will be accepting entries on a 'first come' basis, with exception of the 200m events which will be based on a fastest entry times on an age grouped basis.** Each received entry disc/form will be numbered, and these entries will, assuming that there are no errors, be fully accepted in sequence, until the age-grouped heats have started to be filled. As soon as possible after the closing date, any information in respect of entries not accepted will be sent to clubs/competitors. All refunds will be made 'en block' to the club submitting the entries, these will be sent by post or available for collection by Clubs on the day. There will be no refunds for withdrawals after the closing date. **Coach packs will be available for collection on the day of the Meet.**
- 8 All events are being swum as open age, however awards will be age grouped. **Ages will be as at 12th July 2015** Swim Meet entries may be managed by computer. By submitting entries, consent is thereby given, as required under the data Protection Act of 1998, to the holding of personal information on a computer. Personal data, including submitted and recorded times, may be made public during the meet.
- 9 Under ASA child protection laws all spectators wishing to use cameras must register with the door admission staff.
- 10 The one start rule will be in operation during this event.
- 11 The meet will be run without cards. Heats will be pre seeded. **Swimmers do not need to sign in.** The organizers reserve the right to amend the running order of the events and to add non-scoring swimmers at their sole discretion should it become necessary. If time permits the organisers reserve the right to accept 'Deck Entries' on the day however these swimmers will be entered as Time Trials only. Swimmers must comply with the Meet maximum qualifying times required.
- 12 All 100 and 200m events will be **HDW**. Entries will be seeded into heats from submitted times, these will be seeded before the event, where swimmers have withdrawn the lane will be left empty. Slowest heats will be swum first. All heats will be placed in 'spearhead' formation. There will be senior and junior finals in all 50m events, these finalists will be the fastest 8 swimmers in each age group. Two reserves will be named for these finals.
- 13 Competitors must report to the stewards 2 events prior to their event.
- 14 There will be medals for the top three overall swimmers in the 100m and 200m events in each age group. For the 50m events there will only be medals for the top 8 finalists in each age band. Any disqualified swimmer will not receive awards. There will also be awards for visiting Top Boy & Top Girl. These will be calculated using a points system based on swimmers achieving 1st to 8th places in each of the 100 and 200 events in each age band. Top visiting club award will be calculated using the same points system.
- 15 Only swimmers reporting for their event and appointed officials are allowed on poolside during the competition. During warm-ups only coaches holding the valid Meet pass will be allowed on poolside. Wet swimmers are not allowed in spectator areas.
- 16 There is good parking adjacent to the Pool complex, and cafeteria facilities within the complex.
- 17 The promoter reserves the right to make any alterations to these conditions if necessary and all participants will be notified. Any matter not covered by these conditions or by ASA laws or technical rules will be at the promoter's discretion.
- 18 Any swimmer breaking these conditions will be liable to disqualification from any or all events.
- 19 All visiting Clubs should supply at least one official. Expenses will be offered to officials attending this meet.

SKINS EVENTS

1. The 'Skins Events' will be a continuous event commencing with 8 competitors and over a continuous series of races over a distance of 50m. Two competitors to be eliminated in each round until a winner is determined. Races in each competition will take place following an interval of 90 seconds from the start of the previous race.
2. Skins competitions will be held between sessions one and two on each day, before the warm up. Saturday schedule (Event 1) 13 & under Girls, (Event 2) 14 and over Girls. Sunday Schedule (Event 3) 13 & under Boys, (Event 4) 14 and over Boys. Events will swim concurrently, with a separation of 90 seconds between the starts of each event. The 13 & under event starts first on each day.
3. The cash prize for each event will be £25 for 1st £20 for 2nd 2 x £15 for 3rd 2 x £10 for 4th and 2 x £5 for first elimination, for each 'Skins' age category and gender.
4. Following events, (101) Girls 200 free & (301) Boys 200 free, the eight highest scoring competitors within each 'Skins' age group will be invited to take part in the appropriate age group 'Skins' event. If a swimmer declines to accept their place in the event then the next highest scoring competitor will be offered the place.
5. Lanes will be allocated on the basis of 'spearheading' in accordance with FINA swimming rule SW312 – the swimmer with the highest overall points tally occupying the centre lane. Swimmers are required to swim in their allocated lane whilst they remain in the competition until the final race. The remaining two swimmers will occupy the centre lanes – the right most swimmer occupying Lane 3 the second swimmer in Lane 4.
6. The stroke for each individual race will be by random selection from a choice of Freestyle, Breaststroke, Butterfly and Backstroke. The stroke selection for all races will be by random selection from the declared inclusive strokes. The first race stroke selection will be made by the Meet Referee or other designated person. Subsequent selections will be made by an eliminated competitor from the previous race or other designated person.
7. Each race shall be over a distance of 50m.
8. all races swimmers are required to comply with the FINA Swimming Rules regarding Stroke and Finish conditions – failure to do so will lead to elimination by disqualification – any competitor so eliminated will receive any prize money won to that time including the round in which eliminated.
9. Subsequent rounds will start at the starting end of the pool, following an interval of 90 seconds from the previous Start. A warning whistle will be blown 10 seconds prior to the Starting signal being sounded. Competitors' feet, or hands in the case of Backstroke must be in contact with the Starting Platform or Grips when the Start Signal is given. A swimmer who starts before the starting signal will be eliminated by disqualification. For Backstroke rounds competitors will start in the water with both hands.
